Submit 402 motions in writing along with jury instructions and verdict forms at the beginning of the trial.

Voir Dire You have TIME!!!! So take it. Your examples need to be more sophisticated than cookie crumbs, cherry pies or other simplistic examples. If the crime is serious you want to be careful of using trivial examples as they devalue your case. Current events and other serious crimes not charged in your case are good. C.C.P. 223 Piberal and probing examination calculated to discover bias or prejudice with regard to the circumstances of the particular case or partied before the court. Prohibits the court from imposing "unreasonable or arbitrary time limits" or from establishing "an inflexible time limit policy for voir dire"

Protecting the Record: Protecting the Record: Rules: Capital cases: everything is on the record, even scheduling. You need to know this in case you are asked to make an appearance on a capital case. Life Cases: summarize any discussions off the record of significance and put them on the record or ask the court to make a record.
